










# Windows 8 Quick Start

Action	Touch	Mouse	Keyboard
Open Start screen or previous app (alternating)	Swipe from right edge, tap Start	Click bottom left corner (repeat)	
Switch to the next open app	Swipe from left edge	Click top left corner (repeat)	 + Tab (Release Tab, repeat)
Close active App	Swipe from top edge all the way to the bottom	Click at the top edge and drag to the bottom.	Alt + F4
Reveal app commands	Swipe from bottom edge or top edge	Right-click app in open space or on Start, right-click a tile.	 + Z
Snap app right * (rminimum resolution 1366x768)	Swipe from left edge, drag app to the right.	Hover top left corner, move down to the edge. Click and drag app to right.	 + .
Snap app left * (rminimum resolution 1366x768)	Swipe from left edge, drag app to the left.	Hover top left corner, move down the edge. Click and drag app to left.	 + Shift + .
Open charms	Swipe from the right edge.	Hover top right corner, move down the edge.	 + C
Open Search charm on files	Swipe from right edge, tap Search, then Files	Hover top right corner, click <b>Search</b> , then <b>Files</b> .	 + F
Open Search charms on active app	In an app, swipe from right edge, tap Search	In an app, over top right corner, click <b>Search</b> .	 + Q
Search apps	Swite from right edge, tap Search.	Hover to right cornere, click <b>Search</b> .	Start typing on the Start Screen.
Open Share charms	Swipe from right edge, tap Share.	Hover top right corner, click <b>Share</b> .	 + Tab

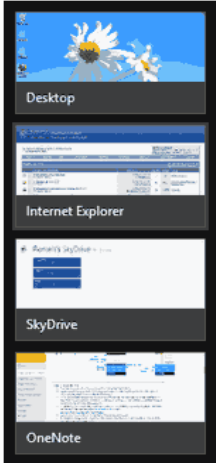

Each arrow in this example starts where you would touch the screen and points towards the example of each feature.

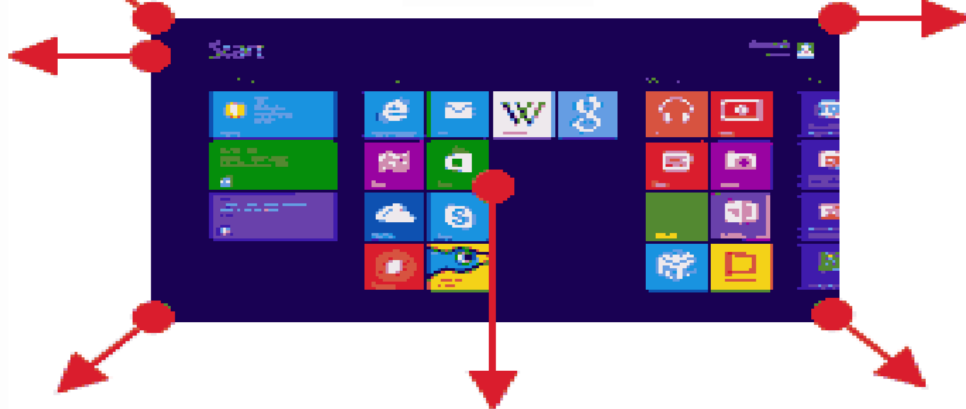

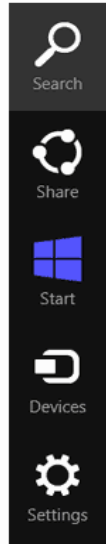

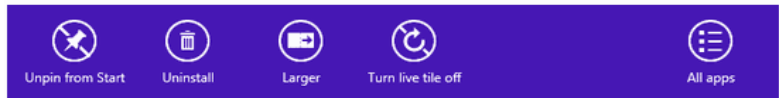
